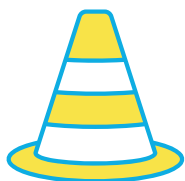


## LINE A WORKS IN THE SECTOR BETWEEN CHOISEUL AND TOURS STATION

**From July 6 to August 28, 2026**

The Tours Mobility Syndicate is launching works this summer to secure and modernize the tramway infrastructure.



### What do the works consist of ?

In Tours, the tramway operates partly via a Ground-Level Power Supply in the sector between the Place Choiseul station and the Gare de Tours (Tours Station) station. This so-called APS system provides traction current to the tramway using a central rail embedded in the ground between the running rails.

Certain APS rails located at intersections are heavily strained by passing vehicles and can become weakened, impacting operations. These APS beams will therefore be replaced by a new, more robust model at the following intersections:

- Place Choiseul
- Place Jean-Jaurès
- Rue Charles-Gille / Avenue Grammont



### Construction Stages

For each intersection concerned, works will take place during the day in several phases:

- 1. Setup and securing of the construction site**
- 2. Removal of APS rails and concrete from the platform**
- 3. Installation of the new APS beams**
- 4. Restoration of the platform**  
A drying period of approximately three weeks will be required before returning to service.
- 5. Reopening to traffic**  
After validation of the tests, tramway traffic will be able to resume, and then road traffic will be restored intersection by intersection until the end of August.



### What are the impacts?

**Tram line A will be cut from July 6 to August 14 between Place Choiseul and Tours Station.** During this period, the tram will only run between Vaucanson and Place Choiseul, as well as between Gare de Tours and Lycée Jean Monnet. Buses will provide a connection between the 2 stations, notably the Plan B bus shuttle specifically set up during the construction phase, as well as Line 14 and Line 12.

**The works will impact bus traffic throughout the summer period across Place Jean-Jaurès, Avenue Grammont, and Place Choiseul.** Bus line diversions will be put in place from July 6 to August 28 across the entire Fil Bleu network to adapt to the works. 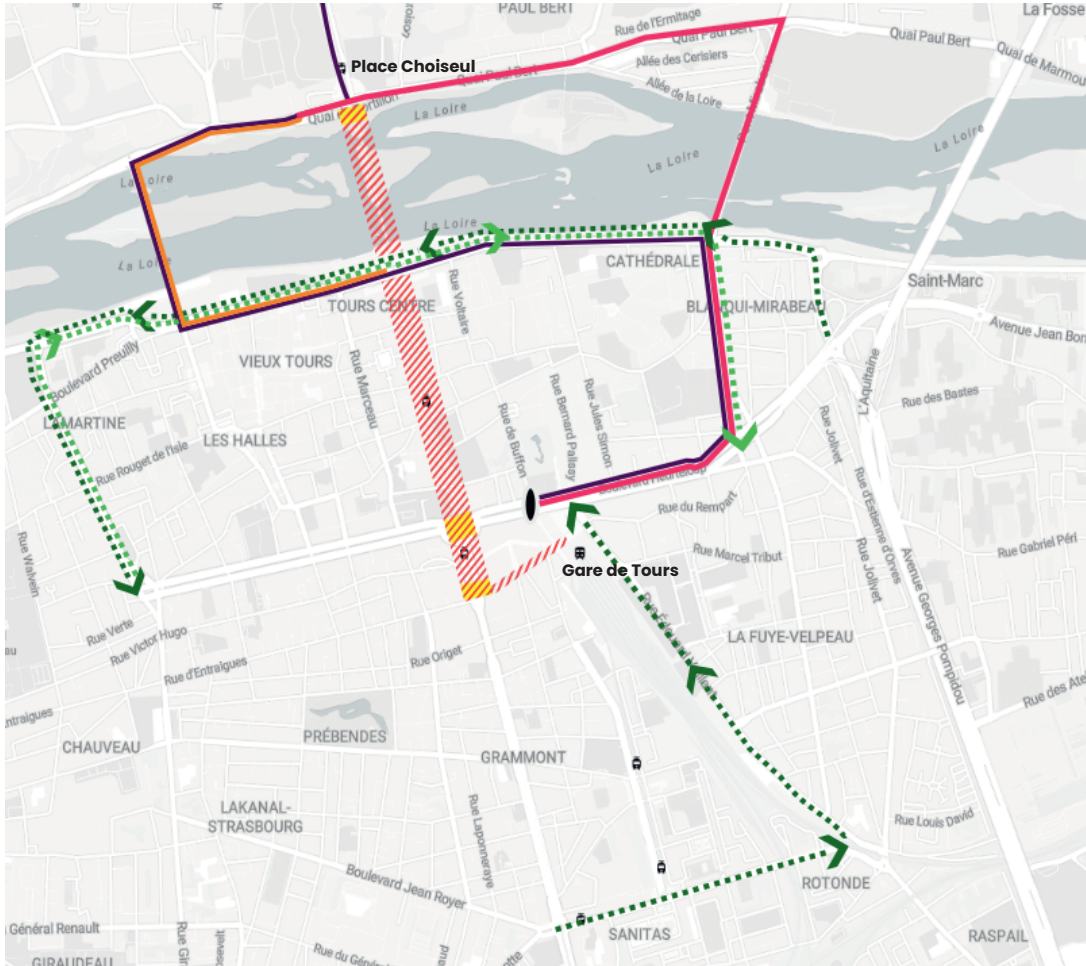
**These works will impact traffic in the hyper-center of Tours.**

In order to maintain travel options, diversion routes will be set up:

- **East-West Axis** : diversion via Avenue André-Malraux, Place Anatole-France and Rue des Tanneurs ;
- **South-North Axis** : diversion via Avenue du Général-de-Gaulle and Rue Édouard-Vaillant.

Specific signage will accompany these measures to guide you and limit the impact on your travel.
